POSITION SUMMARY:

New Life Mission Church is a PCA Korean American church that was planted in 2004 with the vision of becoming a church that: 1. Glorifies God 2. Enjoys His Presence 3. Proclaims the Gospel to the world. Their goal is to be ONE CHURCH who reaches out to Korean Americans of all generations in the greater Denver area.

<u>English Ministry</u>: The English Ministry was established to see the gospel be reached out to the Englishspeaking Korean Americans. As the gospel usually does, it has transformed the ministry organically to reflect a more multi-ethnic congregation.

<u>Goal</u>: Train and equip the ministry intern to be a pastoral candidate in the future for the glory of God and the good of the church.

 - Construct weekly program for worship.
 - Contact leaders and members for administrative purposes.
 - Manage and coordinate FB for EM.
 - Attend Core meetings.
 - Fulfill other pastoral responsibilities as delegated by the EM pastor.
- Ministry
 - Assist in leading and revitalizing college ministry.
 - Lead/teach different activities/programs under pastoral supervision.
 - Slowly have opportunities to preach under pastoral supervision.
 - Start process for the pastoral ministry.

- Work in a diverse and multi-ethnic setting.
- Fulfill other pastoral responsibilities as delegated by the pastor.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
